

SETTING UP A MYMEDICARE.GOV ACCOUNT

1. Click on "Log In / Create Account": Look for a button or link that says "Log In" or "Create Account." Click on it to proceed.
2. Choose "Create Account": Since you're setting up a new account, select the option to "Create Account" or "Sign Up."
3. Verify Your Identity: You'll need to verify your identity to ensure the security of your account. Medicare may ask for some personal information, such as your Medicare number, Social Security number, date of birth, and other identifying details.

9. Log In: Once your account is activated, go back to the Medicare website and log in using your newly created username and password.
10. Explore Your My Medicare Account: Congratulations, you should now have access to your My Medicare account! You can use it to manage your Medicare benefits, view claims, check your coverage, find doctors, and more.
