Finding & Enrolling In Part D Prescription Drug Plans

Once you have your Mymedicare.gov account set up you will be able to search and enroll in Part D plans.

- Log into your account
- Click on Find Health & Drug plans
- Click on Your Drug List
- Click on Add Recently filled Drugs (This will populate your drug list, medications filled using GoodRX will not show up, they must be manually added).
- Review your RX list to make sure that these are the prescriptions that you will be using
***Make sure to delete any drugs you no longer take i.e. antibiotics
- Click on Ready to Shop for Plans
- Click on Find Plans Now
- Enter your zip code then hit continue.
- Medicare Drug Plans (Part D) click on Find Plans
- Search Preferences – DO you want to see Drug costs when you compare plans?
Click YES then Next
- Make sure your drug list is correct (make any changes needed) Click Next
- Confirm List Click Done Adding Drugs
- List Pharmacies (you can add up to 5 pharmacies to compare) Click Done
- View All Filters *IMPORTANT* Sort plans by LOWEST DRUGS & PREMIUM COST
- Your CURRENT Part D Plan will be listed at the top for easy comparison.
- ENROLL – you will need to make sure that any information that is prepopulated is correct, you may also need to fill in some info.
